Summary

The segment consists of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 119) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994, through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on December 11, 1994, through December 16, 1994. Several photo contact sheets in this segment from December 11, 1994, were previously processed in case 2018-0084-F. The Finding Aid inventory will reflect the previously processed photo contact sheets. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from December 11, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meet and greet guests at the final Plenary Session at the Summit of the Americas in Miami, Florida. President Clinton confers with Vice President Albert Gore, Mickey Kantor, and others in their meeting room at the Summit of the Americas in Miami. President Clinton meets and greets various leaders at the Summit of Americas in Miami. This occurred prior to a press conference relating to the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA). President Clinton greets police and drivers in Miami. President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore greet Summit of the Americas heads of state during a coffee reception at the Hyatt Regency in Miami. President Clinton, First Lady Hillary

Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton attend the annual "Christmas in Washington" performance at the National Building Museum in Washington, D.C. The Clintons greet Helen Hunt, Kenny G, George Stevens, Jr., and others. Photographs from December 12, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton participates in a budget briefing in the Cabinet Room with Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary Ron Brown, Laura Tyson, Alice Rivlin, Carol Rasco, Gene Sperling, Jack Quinn, Secretary Robert Reich, George Stephanopoulos, Robert Rubin, Erskine Bowles and others. Meeting participants include Vice President Albert Gore, Jack Gibbons, Carol Browner, and others. Leon Panetta reads and confers in the Outer Oval Office with Mark Gearan, Don Baer, George Stephanopoulos, Bruce Reed, and Betty Currie. The group also meets with Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary Robert Reich, and others. President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office to Chancellor Helmut Kohl of Germany. Jim Reed sets up the telephone call and Leon Panetta is present for the call. President Clinton talks in the Outer Oval Office with Robert Rubin, Alice Rivlin, Billy Webster, and Nancy Hennreich. President Clinton talks alone in the Outer Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore and Leon Panetta. President Clinton participates in a budget briefing in the Cabinet Room with Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Vice President Albert Gore, Robert Rubin, Laura Tyson, Pat Griffin, Alice Rivlin, George Stephanopoulos, Erskine Bowles, Leon Panetta, Gene Sperling, and others. President Clinton meets with President Itamar Franco of Brazil in the Oval Office. Secretary Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, and Mack McLarty are present at the meeting. President Clinton greets Rob Reiner and Annette Bening in the Oval Office. Mack McLarty and Secretary Warren Christopher greet Rob Reiner and Annette Bening in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet guests, including Tim Russert, Mark Knoller, Alan Greenspan, Andrea Mitchell, Robert Novak, and others in the Diplomatic Reception Room during a Christmas reception for the press. Photographs from December 14, 1994, are as follows: President Clinton goes

The Colonnade is decorated with Christmas wreaths. President Clinton participates in a budget briefing in the Cabinet Room. President Clinton meets with Gerald McEntee, AFSCME Union leader, in the Oval Office. Harold Ickes is present at the meeting. President Clinton talks with Leon Panetta and Stephen Goodin in the Oval Office doorway. Views of White House Photo Staff Marilyn Jacanin, Billie Shaddix, and photographer Sharon Farmer in the White House Photo Office. President Clinton confers in the Outer Oval Office with Don Baer, Bruce Reed, George Stephanopoulos, and Mark Gearan. Betty Currie and Nancy Hernreich are present in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton talks in the Outer Oval Office with Nancy Hernreich, Betty Currie, Stephen Goodin, Harold Ickes, and Governor Ned Ray McWherter of Tennessee. Photographs from December 15, 1994, are as follows: President goes jogging near the Lincoln Memorial Reflecting Pool in Washington. Photographs from December 15, 1994, Continued: President Clinton prepares for his Address to the Nation on the Middle Class Bill of Rights in his Treaty Room office. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
