This Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request includes two documents: a cable from Secretary of State Madeleine Albright summarizing a November 8, 1999 meeting with Mexican Secretary of Foreign Affairs Rosario Green, which was also attended by Assistant Secretary Lieberman, and a December 15, 2000 National Security Council email regarding human rights in Vietnam.
