Summary

FOIA 2025-0932-F is a request for all photographs relating to statements delivered by President William Jefferson Clinton regarding bombings of Afghanistan and Sudan. Following bombing attacks on August 7, 1998 at United States embassy locations in Kenya and Tanzania, President Clinton ordered simultaneous strikes of targets located in Afghanistan and Sudan as retaliatory measures.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2025-0932-F is a request for all photographs relating to statements delivered by President William Jefferson Clinton regarding bombings of Afghanistan & Sudan. Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
