Summary

This collection contains records regarding President Bill Clinton's letter to The American Society of Media Photographers on its 50th anniversary. This collection consists of correspondence and draft copies of the letter.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2026-0096-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material.

The American Society of Media Photographers (ASMP), originally named The Society of Magazine Photographers, was founded in 1944 in New York City. ASMP is a professional association of imaging professionals. The organization advocates photographers' legal rights, supports education and information-sharing among members, and provides business and technical information.

The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Alpha file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management from 1993 – 1996 and is a series of documents arranged by name of persons, organizations, or events. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. In addition, there are WHORM, WHORM Counsel, WHORM (CL), WHORM (OP), WHORM (Too Late); WHORM (Various Offices); and WHORM (Alpha Project) series.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
