Summary

The photographs processed in this segment were created on February 9, 1995 through February 13, 1995. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2016-0985-F (Segment 13) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1995 through December 31, 1995. The photographs processed in this segment were created on February 9, 1995 through February 13, 1995. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Photographs from February 9, 1995 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton & Chancellor Helmut Kohl participate in a joint press conference in Room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building. Also photographed is Vice President Albert Gore, Jr. Chancellor Kohl departs outside of the West Wing of the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet Chancellor Helmut Kohl at the South Portico of the White House. Also photographed are Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Mary Elizabeth "Tipper" Gore, and Secretary of State Warren Christopher in the Diplomatic Reception Room. The President, First Lady, and Chancellor Kohl stand at the bottom of the Grand Staircase in the Grand Foyer. They greet guests at dinner in the Grand Foyer. Tony Bennett and a German choral group provide entertainment. Guests are also greeted in the Blue Room. The

President & First Lady dance in the Grand Foyer. Also photographed are table settings. Photographs from February 10, 1995 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a scheduling meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Billy Webster, Leon Panetta, George Stephanopoulos, Nancy Hernreich, Beth Alpert, Don Baer, Anne Walley, and Stephanie Streett. President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Laura Tyson, Alcie Rivlin, Joseph Stiglitz, Martin Baily, Secretary of the Treasury Robert Rubin, Leon Panetta, and George Stephanopoulos. President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with Pat Griffin, Leon Panetta, Erskine Bowles, Harold Ickes, George Stephanopoulos, Mark Gearan, and John Podesta. The President proceeds to the Outer Oval Office and laughs with Vice President Albert Gore. Jr., while they read a newspaper article. Also photographed are Betty Currie, Wendy Smith, and Nancy Hernreich. President William Jefferson Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore, Jr. speak with Senator Daniel Patrick Moynihan, Senator Patrick Leahy, Senator Dale Bumpers, and Senator Earnest Hollings in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Senator Joseph Biden in the Oval Office of the White House regarding the nomination of Henry Foster as Surgeon General. Also present are Leon Panetta, Pat Griffin, and Evelyn Lieberman. President William Jefferson Clinton greets Carolyn Huber and an unidentified group in the Oval Office of the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton greets individuals in separate greetings in the Oval Office of the White House. The first group is Anne Wexler, Danny Wexler, and Joe Duffey in the Oval Office of the White House. Also photographed is Leon Panetta. The second group the President greets is Ron Oliver and Joel Buckner. Finally, the President greets Diane Schuur, Jason Bearman, and Jennifer Bendall. Schurr poses with Socks the Cat. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton departs Andrews Air Force Base en route New York. Photographed includes Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala and Marian Wright Edelman. 2016-0985-F First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends a memorial service for James P. Grant (former United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund [UNICEF] Executive Director) at the Cathedral of St. John the Divine in New York, New York. The First Lady greets Reverend James Parks Morton and the Grant family. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests at LaGuardia Airport in New York, New York prior to departing en route Andrews Air Force Base. Miscellaneous photographs include a group of Native American students photographed outside the White House. Also present is Loretta Avent. Photographs from February 11, 1995 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton delivers his weekly radio address in the Oval Office of the White House. Present includes a group of DARE (Dare to Keep Kids Off Drugs) children, Attorney General Janet Reno, Dr. Lee Brown, and members of police forces. Following the address the President greets guests present, then later speaks with Michael McCurry, Nancy Hernreich, and Attorney General Reno in the Outer Oval Office. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with senior staff prior to a meeting with Prime Minister JeanLuc Dehaene of Belgium. The President, Vice President Albert Arnold Gore, Jr., and Secretary of State Warren Christopher meeting with Prime Minister Dehaene in the Oval Office, then proceed to lunch in the Roosevelt Room. Later the President bids the Prime Minister farewell at the West Wing porte cochere entrance. Following the Prime Minister's departure the President greets staff in the West Wing lobby including Ginny Terzano, Nancy Hernreich, George Stephanopoulos, and Debi Schiff. Miscellaneous images include a group photographed prior to President William Jefferson Clinton delivering his weekly radio address. Photographs from February 12, 1995 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton depart the Foundry United Methodist Church after attending morning services. President William Jefferson Clinton participates in Middle East peace talks at Blair House in Washington, DC. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Egyptian Foreign Minister Amr Moussa (يسوم دمحم ورم), Israeli Foreign Minister Shimon Peres (שרפ וועמש), Viktor Posuvalyuk (Посувалюк, Виктор Викторович), Abdul Karim Kabariti (دبع ميريكل), and Nabil Sha'ath (نابيل شعث ليبن). Prior to the meeting the President is briefed by Secretary Christopher, Tony Lake, Martin Indyk, Michael McCurry, and George Stephanopoulos, among others, in the Oval Office. The President and Vice President cross Pennsylvania Avenue en route Blair House. Miscellaneous photographs include Chelsea Clinton departing the White House and a crane lifting new glass for windows along the Truman Balcony at the White House. Photographs from February 13, 1995 are as follows: President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Outer Oval Office of the White House with Andrew Friendly and Anne Walley regarding scheduling. Also photographed is Betty Currie and Nancy Hernreich. 2016-0985-F President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Tony Lake in the Oval Office of the White House. Colonel Jim Reed sets up a telephone call for the President, which the President takes at the Resolute Desk. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the export council in the Indian Treaty Room of the White House. Present is Secretary of Commerce Ronald Brown. Prior to the meeting the President meets with Leon

Panetta, Steve Silverman, and George Stephanopoulos in the Oval Office. Also photographed is Marianne Smith in the Old Executive Office Building. President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with Carolyn Curiel, William Galston, George Stephanopoulos, and Leon Panetta. President William Jefferson Clinton greets & addresses a group of state treasurers at the White House. President William Jefferson Clinton meets with science & technology corporate executive officers in the Roosevelt Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of Commerce Ronald Brown, Secretary of Education Richard Riley, Secretary of the Treasury Robert Rubin, and Laura Tyson, among others. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Shaed Elementary School in Washington, DC. Present includes Principal Brenda Richards, Superintendent Dr. Franklin Smith, and students Kevin Cooper & Erica Nedd. The First Lady attends a school program where she sings the National Anthem and later addresses students at the school. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Columbia Hospital for Women in Washington, DC. Present is Chief Financial Officer Marc Engelhart, Associate Administrator Doris Johnson, and Assistant Administrator Dwaine Gasser. The First Lady tours the Betty Ford Comprehensive Center for Breast Cancer and speaks with women who are to receive mammograms. Later the First Lady participates in a panel discussion. Present includes Health Care Finance Administrator Ann Trontell, and physicians & patients at the hospital. Following the panel discussion the First Lady participates in interviews with Kathleen Matthews for Working Woman and Steve Holland for Reuters. Also photographed include Melanne Verveer and Lisa Caputo. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a meeting for the Health and Human Services Steering Committee for the national action plan on breast cancer at the Columbia Hospital for Women in Washington, DC. Present includes Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, Susan Blumenthal, and Fran Visco.

Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
