Summary

The video processed in this case is of a meet & greet at the White House with President-elect Hugo Chavez of Venezuela. President-elect Chavez came to the White House on January 27, 1999.

Scope and Content Note

FOIA 2024-0771-F is a request for all video recordings related to a meet & greet at the White House with President-elect Hugo Chavez of Venezuela. President-elect Chavez came to the White House on January 27, 1999, and President William Jefferson Clinton met with President-elect Chavez in Samuel "Sandy" Berger's office. Also, present is Jim Dobbins.

Material processed as a matter of consequence includes a meet & greet prior to the Millennium lecture series event on January 25, 1999, a departure from the White House via Marine One on January 26, 1999, a meet & greet in the Blue Room prior to an event for Social Security & Medicare on January 27, 1999, a meet & greet prior to an event for the United States Conference of Mayors on January 29, 1999, and a departure from the White House via Marine One on January 30, 1999. Individuals present at these events include President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of Health & Human Services Donna Shalala, Andrew Cuomo, Secretary of Labor Alexis Herman, Mickey Ibara, Sharon Farmer, Ralph Alswang, Ellen Lovell (Director; White House Millennium Council), Natalie Zemon Davis, and Martin E. Marty, among others.

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Video Recordings of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Video Recordings Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the item/tape level. While this method maintains video tape run time integrity, it frequently results in the processing of video material that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
