Summary

This collection consists of schedules, background materials, press releases and pool reports related to President Clinton's daily activities of March 13-14, 1997. It was during this time that President Clinton injured his knee at the home of professional golfer, Greg Norman.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2006-0497-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA request 2006-0497-F consists of schedules, background materials, press releases and pool reports related to President Clinton's daily activities of March 13 and March 14, 1997. President Clinton traveled to Raleigh, North Carolina on March 13 and then onto Miami, Florida that same day. While in Raleigh, President Clinton addressed a joint session of the North Carolina Legislature. Later that day, President Clinton traveled to Miami where he attends a DSCC (Democratic Senatorial Campaign Committee) fundraiser for Senator Phil Graham. President Clinton was scheduled to tour a school and participate in a golf tournament on Friday, March 14. However, President Clinton injured his knee while descending stairs at the home of professional golfer, Greg Norman. President Clinton was flown to Bethesda Maryland on March 14 for knee repair surgery.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area - Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files. As policy, Staff and Office Files are processed at the folder level. That is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 USC 22) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 USC 552 as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (Title 17, USC) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

Provenance

Official records of William Jefferson Clinton's presidency are housed at the Clinton Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).
