## **Summary**

The First Lady and the Principals on a bus tour of the Navy Yard. The First Lady and the group tour the Navy Yard Museum. The First Lady addressing the White House Millennium Council's Washington Navy Yard event. The First Lady greeting military guests at the event. Also, photographs from the July 4, 2000 OPSAIL event in New York, NY are included. These photographs feature President Clinton greeting Jerry Hultin, at the arrival ceremony on the U.S.S. John F.
