

**Extent**

Approximately 30 photographs, in color film processed from 35mm negatives.

**Summary**

This request consists of photographs of President Clinton awarding the National Medal of Arts and Humanities to Ernest J. Gaines at a ceremony at DAR Constitution Hall on December 20, 2000. These photos document the award ceremony and the dinner afterwards at the White House. Gaines is a fiction author and Louisiana native.

**Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2009-0774-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA case 2009-0774-F contains responsive photos from the White House Photograph Office. At the dinner, Ernest Gaines and family are also photographed with the Clintons in the Blue Room of the White House. Ernest J. Gaines is writer of fiction novels and a Louisiana native.
