Two betacam video recordings reviewed and processed.

Summary

This is a video recording of President Clinton's remarks during an interview with CBS Radio on December 11, 1999. The President was interviewed by Mark Knoller and Peter Maer of CBS Radio. The interview took place at an office within the Wyndham Palace Resort Hotel in Orlando, Florida. There is also a video recording from December 11, 1999 at a Unity Reception in Miami, FL. The President makes remarks and greets guests at a private residence.

Scope and Content Note

The material in FOIA 2007-1778-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA request 2007-1778-F includes two selected master tape video recordings from the White House Television Office. The first video recording (MT.10943) contains a December 11, 1999 interview of President Clinton conducted by Mark Knoller and Peter Maer of CBS News. The interview takes place at the Wyndham Palace Resort in Orlando, Florida. The running time of the interview is approximately twenty-four minutes. The second video recording (MT.10946) is from December 11, 1999 at a Unity Reception in Miami, FL. The President makes remarks and greets guests at a private residence. The running time of this event is approximately twenty-nine minutes.

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series— Clinton Presidential Records: Video Recordings of the White House Television Office, and the series therein—Video Recordings Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Video tape level.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 USC 22) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 USC 552 as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Video recordings in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (17 USC 101), which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.

Provenance

Official records of William Jefferson Clinton's presidency are housed at the Clinton Presidential Library and administered by the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA) under the provisions of the Presidential Records Act (PRA).
