**Summary**

This collection consists of records related to President Clinton's trip to dedicate his birthplace home in Hope, Arkansas as a National Historic Site. President Clinton also visited Texarkana and Little Rock, Arkansas on the same trip, from March 11-13, 1999. The records concern the arrangement of the Scheduling and Travel Offices in the White House to procure flights, buses, hotels, and other arrangements needed for the White House and the press pool for the trip.

**Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2012-0550-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA request 2012-0550-F contains trip files concerning the logistics and planning of President Clinton's trip to dedicate his birthplace in Hope, Arkansas as a National Historic Site. The President spent time in Texarkana and Little Rock on the same trip. The records in the collection concern the arrangement of the Scheduling and Travel Offices in the White House to procure flights, buses, hotels, and other arrangements needed for the White House and the press pool for the trip.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area - Clinton Presidential Records: Staff and Office Files. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 USC 2201) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 USC 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
