The records contain the names of people who were invited and/or attended the St. Patrick's Day White House receptions. The records consist of correspondence, memoranda, call logs, schedules, remarks by the President, and lists of people who were invited and/or attended the St. Patrick's Day receptions.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2007-0687-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. FOIA request 2007-0687-F contains correspondence, memoranda, call logs, schedules, remarks by the President, and lists of people who were invited and/or attended the St. Patrick's Day receptions hosted by President Clinton in the years 1998, 1999, and 2000.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas - Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office files. Staff and Office Files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their

individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 USC 2201) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 USC 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
