Approximately 519 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Summary

This collection consists of photographs relating to President Clinton and Winfield House in London, England. Winfield House is the residence of the U.S. Ambassador to the United Kingdom.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in Systematic request 2006-1854-S are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the request. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. Systematic request 2006-1854-S contains responsive photographs from the White House Photograph Office pertaining to President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton and Winfield House in London, England. The Clintons visited Winfield House on November 29-30, 1995, May 29, 1997, and May 18, 1998. The Winfield House is the U.S. Ambassador to the United Kingdom (UK) residence in London. The photographs from November 29-30, 1995 document the Clintons official arrival to Winfield House via Marine One (HMX-1). The Clintons participate in a ceremonial tree planting on the grounds of Winfield House. President Clinton and Hillary Rodham Clinton attend a reception hosted by Ambassador Crowe. Ambassador Crowe presents the Clintons with a framed cartoon at the reception. President Clinton delivers remarks at the reception. The Clintons greet reception guests and Winfield House staff. President Clinton makes a press statement outside of Winfield House with Prime Minister Tony Blair. The Clintons depart Winfield House via Marine One on November 30, 1995. Prior to the Clintons departure photographs are taken with police and guests at Winfield House. The photographs from May 29, 1997 document a U.S. Embassy event at Winfield House. The Clintons greet Ambassador James Crowe and Shirley Crowe. President Clinton

and Hillary Rodham Clinton attend the embassy event and greet embassy staff. President Clinton makes remarks at the event. The Clintons greet military personnel at Winfield House. There are photos of the exterior of Winfield House during this event. The photographs from May, 18, 1998 document President Clinton's arrival to Winfield House via Marine One. President Clinton is accompanied by Prime Minister Tony Blair on his visit to Winfield House. President Clinton greets Ambassador Phil Lader and family and the party walks the grounds. President Clinton greets military personnel and guests at Winfield House.

Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level.
