Summary

This collection consists of the subject files of Heather Howard from her time in the Domestic Policy Council. Howard was Associate Director for Domestic Policy from 2000 to the end of the Administration who specialized in children and family issues relating to abortion, partial birth abortion, consumer product safety, prescription drugs, mental health, and violence against women. Heather Howard's records include reports, handwritten notes, memoranda, draft legislation, articles, emails, faxes, publications, and correspondence.

Scope and Content Note

Within the Domestic Policy Council, Heather Howard was Associate Director for Domestic Policy, specializing in Children and Families, from 2000 to the end of the Administration. This series of Subject Files highlights women and children health care topics relating to abortion, partial birth abortion, consumer product safety, prescription drugs, mental health, and violence against women. The records include reports, handwritten notes, memoranda, draft legislation, articles, emails, faxes, publications, and correspondence.
