Summary

This collection consists of records related to the pardon process for James Lake. Mr. Lake was charged with wire fraud, aiding and abetting the making of an illegal corporate campaign contribution, and aiding and abetting the making of an illegal conduit campaign contribution. He was sentenced on January 30, 1998. President Clinton pardoned Mr. Lake on January 20, 2001. The records include correspondence requesting that James Lake be granted a pardon, a personal statement by James Lake, and character affidavits.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in 2013-1026-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. This FOIA consists of records relating to the pardon process for James Lake. Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. 2013-1026-F <http://www.clintonlibrary.gov> - 2 - Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
