**Summary**

This collection consists of records related to trade and Nicaragua. It contains National Security Council (NSC) Cables and Emails from 1993 to 2001. These records include Trade Act and Trade Estimate reports, as well as an email conversation concerning trade meetings on Central American Issues, specifically the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), in September 1994.

**Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2016-0862-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. This collection contains National Security Council (NSC) Cables and Emails with subject lines concerning trade and Nicaragua. After the Nicaraguan Revolution ended in 1990, the United States, under the Clinton Administration, endeavored to pursue positive trade relations with Nicaragua and support the country in its transition to democracy. The NSC Cables consist of reports regarding Nicaraguan trade relations, both with the United States and other nations. These records include the Trade Act Reports for the years 1994, 1996, and 1997, as well as Trade Estimate Reports for the years 1996, 1997, 2000, and 2001. The NSC Emails contain a conversation between Jeri Jensen-Moran and Richard Feinberg regarding trade meetings on Central American issues, specifically the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA), in September 1994.
