Summary

This collection consists of records related to Tim Connolly, the Department of Defense's Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary for Special Operation and Low Intensity Conflict from August 1993 to April 1996. It contains biographical materials, from, emails, memoranda, and resumes concerning Connolly's appointment to and dismissal from this position.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2014-0423-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Tim Connolly served as the Department of Defense's Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary for Special Operations and Low Intensity Conflict (SOLIC) from August 1993 to April 1996. Low intensity elements of Connolly's position included operational support for civil, humanitarian, and refugee affairs in both Rwanda and the Balkans. In this capacity, Connolly coordinated with international assistance, development, and humanitarian agencies. FOIA 2014-0423-F contains biographies, forms, memoranda, emails and resumes. These materials concern the appointment of Tim Connolly to Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary for Special Operations and Low Intensity Conflict (SOLIC) in the summer of 1993, as well as his departure from that position in April 1996.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in the Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files and Clinton Presidential Records: NSC Cables, Emails and Records Management System (RMS). Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.

Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

Copyright

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (17 U.S.C. Chapter 1) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.
