Summary

This collection consists of records related to White House Personnel reports for 1995 through 2000. Section 6 of Public Law 103-270 requires that on July 1 of each year the President submit a report to the Senate and the House of Representatives listing the name, position and annual salary for each individual employed by or detailed to the White House Office. The Law was approved on June 30, 1994 and took effect on January 1, 1995. Report analysis, which breaks down the staff list by race and sex, is included for years 1996-1997 and 1999-2000.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2014-0939-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. Section 6 of Public Law 103-270 requires that on July 1 of each year the President submit a report on White House Office personnel to the Committee on Governmental Affairs of the Senate and the Committee on Government Operations of the House of Representatives. The report lists the name of each individual employed by or detailed to the White House Office, their position and title, and their annual rate of pay. The Law was approved on June 30, 1994 and took effect on January 1, 1995. Records responsive to this FOIA include White House Office personnel reports for 1995 through 2000. Also included are transmittal letters to members of the two Congressional committees, talking points and report drafts. Report analysis, which breaks down the staff list by race and sex, is included for years 1996 - 1997 and 1999 - 2000.

Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity.

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.
