Summary

This collection consists of records related to correspondence from conservative activist Phyllis Schlafly to the President. This collection consists of a letter sent by Schlafly to the President suggesting a tax-cut and a letter objecting to the President's appearance on a television channel broadcast in schools. Neither letter generated a response from the White House.

Scope and Content Note

The materials in FOIA 2015-0052-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. Phyllis Schlafly is a conservative activist and founder of the advocacy group known as the Eagle Forum. She was a vocal critic of the Equal Rights Amendment (ERA) in the early 1970's, and is an outspoken supporter of traditional family values and gender roles. Records responsive to this FOIA include a letter sent by Schlafly to the President suggesting a tax-cut and a letter objecting to the President's appearance on a television channel broadcast in schools.
