**Summary**

This collection consists of records relating to President Clinton's visit to ILC Technology, Inc. in Sunnyvale, CA. ILC Technology Inc. is in the design, development, manufacture, and marketing of specialized lights and lasers for medicine, industrial, aerospace, scientific, entertainment, and military industries. The records in this collection contain memoranda, briefing papers, schedules, news articles, and a briefing book.

**Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2012-0948-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials. ILC Technology, Inc. is in the design, development, manufacture, and marketing of specialized lights and lasers for medicine, industrial, aerospace, scientific, entertainment, and military industries. ILC Technology was incorporated in 1967. The collection contains memoranda, briefing papers, schedules, news articles and a Briefing Book relating to the President's trip to California on September 10, 1993.

Records that are responsive to this FOIA request were found in these collection areas - Clinton Presidential Records: WHORM Subject Files, Clinton Presidential Records: White House Staff and Office Files The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and correspondence. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination Staff and Office files were maintained at the folder level by staff members within their individual offices and document all levels of administration activity. WHORM files are processed at the document level; whereas, Staff and Office files are processed at the folder level, that is, individual documents are not selected and removed from a folder for processing. While this method maintains folder integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of documents that are not wholly responsive to the subject area. FOIA 2012-0948-F includes WHORM records from these subject codes: FG Federal Government - Organizations.

### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

### **Copyright**

Documents in this collection that were prepared by officials of the United States government as part of their official duties are in the public domain. Researchers are advised to consult the copyright law of the United States (17 U.S.C. Chapter 1) which governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material.
