## **Summary**

This collection consists of records relating to all communications made to the Clinton Administration supporting Bob F. Griffin's application for presidential clemency. The records include correspondence to President William J. Clinton regarding Bob F. Griffin's application for presidential clemency. Griffin was granted clemency by President Clinton in January 2001.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The materials in FOIA 2010-0248-F are a selective body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related material. Bob F. Griffin served as Speaker of the Missouri House of Representatives from 1981 to 1995. FOIA request 2010-0248-F contains records from the WHORM Subject Files. The records consist of correspondence to President William J. Clinton regarding Bob F. Griffin's application for presidential clemency.

## **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area – Clinton Presidential Records: White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) Subject Files. The White House Office of Records Management (WHORM) contains a variety of series created to organize and track documents and

correspondence. The WHORM Subject file was compiled by the White House Office of Records Management and is a series of categories designated by a letter/number combination. WHORM files are processed at the document level. FOIA 2010-0248-F includes WHORM records from these subject codes: JL001 Amnesty - Clemency - Pardons JL003 Criminal Matters.

## **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

## **Copyright**
