SUBJECT: Suggested human rights monitors

First choice:

Monique Mujawamariya of Rwanda. (Mujawamariya also monitors Burundi. The President just signed a Determination providing \$4.5 million in relief for Burundian refugees fleeing into Rwanda and elsewhere, so that is a hook of sorts.) Trained as a social worker, she is executive director of the Rwandan Association for the Defense of Human Rights and Public Liberties. She investigates and publishes reports on a variety of human rights abuses by both civilian and military authorities. When she uncovered proof of summary executions by government soldiers, she led Africa Watch representatives to the bush to locate and photograph the remains of victims. She has witnessed massacres by government forces of the Tutsi tribe and enlisted the diplomatic community to intercede with the government to halt the killings.

She and her colleagues have come under tremendous pressure and a photo op would provide her with a measure of much-needed protection.
