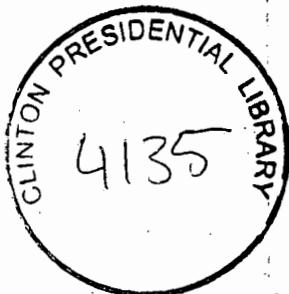

JOINT DRAFT REPLY

Dear Governor Tenorio:

Thank you for your letter of February 16 in which you raise citizenship and immigration issues as they relate to the Covenant.

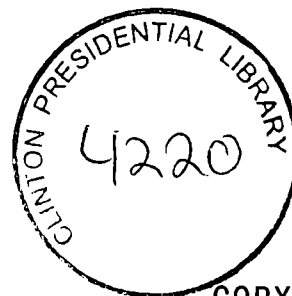
I have been advised that the issue of whether "green cards" should be issued to immediate relatives of U.S. citizens residing in the Commonwealth was recently reviewed by the Acting General Counsel of the Immigration and Naturalization Service and that the concerns which you raise regarding Section 906 of the Covenant were addressed in the Acting General Counsel's opinion. I have enclosed a copy of that opinion for your information.

The Federal Government, of course, will be pleased to consult with Mr. Salas on the question of the citizenship of persons born to alien parents in the Commonwealth. I believe, however, that the discussion of a single legal issue does not warrant the appointment of a separate Special Representative, especially since you have already designated Ms. Brenda Tenorio as your Special Representative under Section 902 of the Covenant. Consequently, I am instructing the Department of Justice to designate a qualified person to consult with Mr. Salas on the question of citizenship of persons born in the Commonwealth to alien parents.

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I greatly appreciate the spirit of cooperation shown in your inauguration address and look forward to the harmonious solution of any problems that may arise in the future.

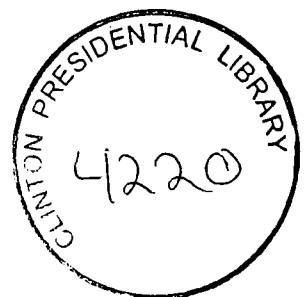
