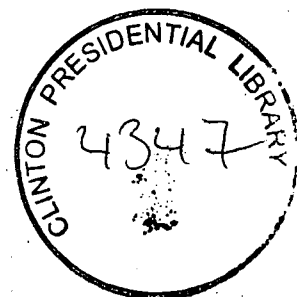
I have had the strong support from both Senator Biden and Chairman Lee Hamilton and have been assured of their continued support for this new position.

I. BACKGROUND

The Board is an independent federal agency responsible for the oversight of Radio Free Europe/Radio Liberty, Inc. (RFE/RL). In fulfilling its mission, the Board assesses the quality and effectiveness of RFE/RL within the broad foreign policy objectives of the United States. The Board also develops and audits the financial procedures of RFE/RL while allowing RFE/RL to maintain its professional independence. The Board has an annual operating budget of \$220 million and employs a full-time professional staff of 18 Federal career employees.

II. DISCUSSION

The Board is composed of the CEO of RFE/RL, who serves ex officio, and nine members appointed by the President with the advice and consent of the Senate. Of the Presidential appointees, there are currently four members whose terms have expired and three members whose terms will expire on April 28, 1993. This memorandum addresses the designation of one of the current members, Daniel Mica (D-FL), to replace Malcolm Forbes, Jr., as Chair, in order to ensure a more cooperative relationship with the Board as the Administration and the Congress pursue the restructuring of our country's international broadcasting operations.

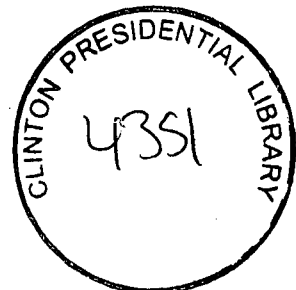

DANIEL MICA, Democrat of Florida, to be Chair of the Board for International Broadcasting, vice Malcolm Forbes, Jr. Mr. Mica is the former U.S. Representative from the 14th Congressional District of Florida (1979-1989) and has served on the Board since 1991. While a Member of Congress, he served on the House Committee on Foreign Relations and was appointed by President Reagan as the Congressional Representative to the United Nations. Mr. Mica is currently the Executive Vice President for Federal Affairs for the American Council of Life Insurance.

**BOARD FOR INTERNATIONAL BROADCASTING
BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

METHOD OF APPOINTMENT: PAS - The members of the Board are appointed by the President with the advice and consent of the United States Senate.

SENATE COMMITTEE REFERRAL: Nominations to the Board will be referred to the Senate Committee on Foreign Relations.

AUTHORIZING STATUE OR EXECUTIVE ORDER: 22 U.S.C. 2872

CABINET DEPARTMENT AFFILIATION: Independent.

COMPOSITION: The Board shall be composed of 10 members, as follows:

- the CEO of RFE\RL, who shall serve as an ex officio member; and,
- Nine (9) public members, not more than five (5) of whom shall be members of the same political party.

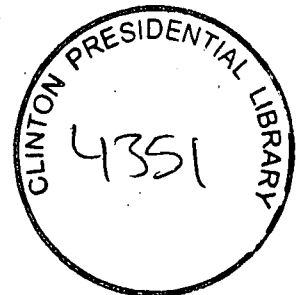
OTHER MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS: Members must be citizens of the United States. Public members may not be current full-time employees of the U.S. government. Members should be knowledgeable of foreign policy or mass communications.

TERM LENGTHS: Members shall serve for terms of three (3) years and shall continue to serve after the expiration of their terms until a successor has been appointed.

COMPENSATION: Members receive no salary but are compensated for travel expenses. A per diem is provided as per 5 U.S.C. 5316. As of January, 1992, members received a per diem of \$400.

METHOD OF CHAIR SELECTION: The President shall designate one of the members to serve as Chair.

STAFF SELECTION: The Board shall appoint and employ personnel in accordance with the requirements of Title 5.

FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS: Board meetings are scheduled three times per year. The members meet at other times during the year as required.

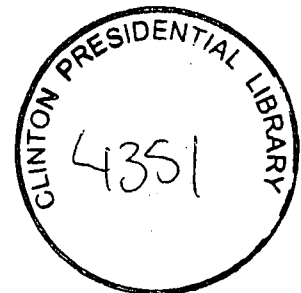
