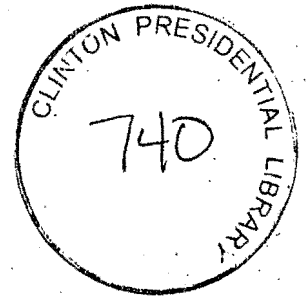

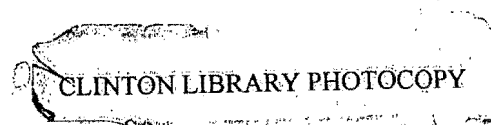

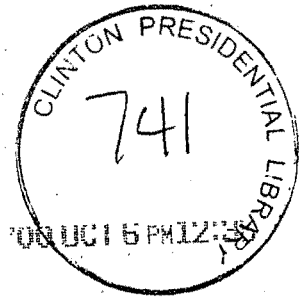
SUBJECT: Attached Executive Clemency Memoranda

Attached are four memoranda listing executive clemency matters for your consideration. The first submits 7 pardon requests, which we recommend you grant. The second lists 34 cases in which you have previously denied pardons, but which we believe you may wish to reconsider. If you would like to pardon those individuals, we will contact them to ensure they still wish to be pardoned. Once we have confirmation both that you would like to pardon the individual and that the individual still seeks that pardon, we will communicate your decision to the Department of Justice. The third memorandum recommends that you grant a commutation in the case of Vicki Lopez-Lukis. The fourth recommends that you deny several commutation requests.
