As you will recall, on 17th September, 1996, the World Solar Summit held in Harare, Zimbabwe, adopted by acclamation the Harare Declaration on Solar Energy and Sustainable Development and an Outline of the World Solar Programme 1996-2005. Article 16 of the Harare Declaration invited the World Solar Commission to continue to play a leading role in the development of the World Solar Programme 1996-2005. The Summit also mandated the World Solar Commission to finalise the preparation of a detailed World Solar Programme within a period of nine months.

I am delighted to inform you that on the occasion of the Special Session of the United Nations General Assembly held to Review and Appraise the Implementation of Agenda 21, the World Solar Commission, at its Second Session held on the 23rd of June, 1997, at the United Nations Headquarters in New York, approved

1. PLEASE DELIVER THE FOLLOWING LETTER TO PRESIDENT CLINTON FROM PRESIDENT HUGABE INFORMING HIM OF THE UN'S APPROVAL OF THE WORLD SOLAR PROGRAMME 1996-2005 DOCUMENT. ORIGINAL IS BEING POUCHED TO AF/S.

2. BEGIN TEXT:

DEAR MR. PRESIDENT,

AS YOU WILL RECALL, ON 17TH SEPTEMBER, 1996, THE WORLD SOLAR SUMMIT HELD IN HARARE, ZIMBABWE, ADOPTED BY ACCLAMATION THE HARARE DECLARATION ON SOLAR ENERGY AND SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT AND AN OUTLINE OF THE WORLD SOLAR PROGRAMME 1996-2005. ARTICLE 16 OF THE HARARE DECLARATION INVITED THE WORLD SOLAR COMMISSION TO CONTINUE TO PLAY A LEADING ROLE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE WORLD SOLAR PROGRAMME 1996-2005. THE SUMMIT ALSO MANDATED THE WORLD SOLAR COMMISSION TO FINALISE THE PREPARATION OF A DETAILED WORLD SOLAR PROGRAMME WITHIN A PERIOD OF NINE MONTHS.

I AM DELIGHTED TO INFORM YOU THAT ON THE OCCASION OF THE SPECIAL SESSION OF THE UNITED NATIONS GENERAL ASSEMBLY HELD TO REVIEW AND APPRAISE THE IMPLEMENTATION OF AGENDA 21, THE WORLD SOLAR COMMISSION, AT ITS SECOND SESSION HELD ON THE 23RD OF JUNE, 1997, AT THE UNITED NATIONS HEADQUARTERS IN NEW YORK, APPROVED BY ACCLAMATION THE DOCUMENT WORLD SOLAR PROGRAMME 1996-2005. THIS DOCUMENT IS AVAILABLE ON INTERNET, AND PRINTED COPIES IN ALL THE OFFICIAL WORKING LANGUAGES OF THE UNITED NATIONS AND WILL SOON BE MAILED BY THE UNESCO SECRETARIAT OF THE WORLD SOLAR COMMISSION.

THE 2.4 BILLION PEOPLE WORLD-WIDE WITHOUT ACCESS TO ENERGY SERVICES AND WHOSE HOPES WERE RAISED BY THE LAUNCHING OF THE WORLD SOLAR PROGRAMME DURING THE WORLD SOLAR SUMMIT AWAIT THE SPECIFICATION AND IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROGRAMME. AS YOU ARE WELL AWARE, THE WORLD SOLAR PROGRAMME HAS THE POTENTIAL TO CHANGE THE COURSE OF LIVES OF MILLIONS OF PEOPLE IN THE WORLD. THE SUCCESSFUL IMPLEMENTATION OF THE WORLD SOLAR PROGRAMME 1996-2005 WILL

NOT ONLY REQUIRE HUMAN RESOURCES BUT ADEQUATE FINANCIAL RESOURCES AS WELL. FURTHERMORE, THE SUCCESSFUL ACCOMPLISHMENT OF THIS HISTORIC MISSION DEPEND ON ALL OF US. I SINCERELY HOPE THAT YOUR GOVERNMENT, AND YOU PERSONALLY, WILL ASSIST IN THE SUCCESSFUL IMPLEMENTATION OF THIS VENTURE WHICH WILL CONSTITUTE AN IMMENSE CONTRIBUTION

TO OUR JOINT EFFORTS TOWARDS THE PRESERVATION OF OUR PLANET AND ENSURE A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE TOWARDS THE PRESERVATION OF OUR PLANET AND ENSURE A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE FOR MANKIND.

PLEASE ACCEPT, YOUR EXCELLENCY, THE RENEWED ASSURANCES OF MY HIGHEST CONSIDERATION.
