Sandy:

I spoke with Bob Bradtke as you suggested about FLOTUS doing a statement in London. He likes the idea and has met with her advance people to discuss doing it at Winfield House shortly after she arrives in front of a small Press pool.

Bradtke says she will be the most prominent guest at the funeral and it is appropriate/expected

that she make a brief statement but answer no questions (to avoid entanglement in what he describes as the increasingly "nasty" Palace politics).

I will proceed to tell Melanne/Marsha Berry that we endorse a FLOTUS statement, unless you disagree.

On attendance, Bradtke says he has heard Kissinger has been invited but no word on whether he will attend. A couple of AMCIT leaders of private landmines-victim-assistance groups may also have been invited (whether to march in the procession, attend the funeral or both I don't know). Rumors persist that Liddy Dole has been invited. Someone named Deda Blair has been invited. I'll ask EUROPE Directorate to do a memo from you to Melanne with list of those going and recommendation(s) on whom to invite along on FLOTUS plane.

Finally, the UK Embassy has asked Larry Butler whether a cousin of Prince Charles, Tim Knatchbull -- also grandson of Lord Mountbatten and present on the boat when Mountbatten was assassinated -- can hitch a ride on FLOTUS plane. I've asked Legal whether any impediments exist to taking him along. If OK with Legal, I'll put to FLOTUS staff.

As far as I know all is set for VP speaking at Nat'l Cathedral service 1pm Saturday, and for his signing condolence book at UK Embassy. I closed the loop with Kerr yesterday, telling him it had been decided VP would do the honors. I've left word with various at the VP's office of this but haven't heard back.
