SUBJECT: Presidential Gifts

This memorandum responds to two issues: gift items on loan at the Residence from the Archives that to date have not been categorized and, 2) a gift misplaced by White House staff.

Certain Gift Items

The Chief Usher of the Executive Residence, Gary Walters, identified several gift items in use or on display in the Residence. See Memorandum from Gary Walters to Tim Flynn, Gift Office Director, January 31, 1994. The National Park Service initially thought these gifts to the President were to be accepted for the permanent White House collection; it therefore sent thank you letters to each of the donors. Upon discovering that the President had indicated a desire to have these items go to the Clinton Presidential library, the National Park Service elected not to accept these items; therefore, the Park Service never declared the gifts as accepted for the permanent White House collection. The Curator of the White House took responsibility for ensuring that the goods were not accepted by the National Park Service.

At this time, these gifts must be declared as personal gift items or items destined for the Clinton Presidential Library (the Archives). Since the President has not stated a desire to accept these items personally, it is my understanding based on the process in place that these gifts should be designated for the Archives and, with the approval of the Archives, on loan to the White House.

Misplaced Gift Item

It is also my understanding from you that the Correspondence Department misplaced a gift item -- a gold saxophone pin from Mr. James Steele valued by him at \$4,200. This item had inadvertently been recorded by your office as personally accepted by the President before you became aware of the fact that the pin had never been conveyed to the President. Indeed, the pin was misplaced before the President even became aware of its

existence. If the circumstances described above are accurate, the President has not personally accepted the pin. Accordingly, an appropriate record change should be made to reflect the fact that this gift was misplaced by staff and never received by the President.
