I am concerned about the endorsement aspect of these letters. I would not have a problem with the President recognizing their contributions in the area of literacy, thanking them for doing their part and acknowledging that they are examples to others. I do not think that the President should encourage them to participate in a particular endeavor. He could cite Levin's involvement in NIL (since it seems he is already involved) as an example of his commitment to literacy issues, but he should not ask Oprah to be involved on NIL's behalf.
