NEW ISSUES

Status of the 229 Nominees Pending Before the Senate

We continue to nominate as many candidates as possible before the Senate sine die adjourns. The White House Counsel vetting team is working feverishly on clearing as many of our priority PAS (Political Appointee with Senate confirmation) as possible. We hope with the continuance measure taken by Congress this week, that we will see more confirmations. We had two confirmations this week: Robert Pirie, Under Secretary of the Navy and Robert Shamansky, Member of the National Security Education Board
