Immigration:

We received very good coverage over the weekend in the L.A. area around the one year anniversary of Gatekeeper. The announcement of the Southwest Border Czar was on the front page on the LA Times, and the San Diego Union. The Times just wrote an editorial praising our selection of Alan Bersin and our entire Administration immigration policy.

The next two weeks are to be focused on the workplace agenda. The Commissioner will announce 200 companies who will participate in the computer verification program in Santa Ana. She has also agreed to announce a new Operation Job sweep in either Georgia, DC area, or Northern California. Finally, we will be honoring here at the White House the person who helped create Operation Job and the agency is producing a report on its success.

The goal is to create controversy on a program which is very popular and brings nothing but praise from the Republicans.

Welfare:

This week the Senate announced their conferees. We expect the conference to start meeting either Tuesday or Friday. Bruce and HHS continue to meet with the Hill staff on the Administrations priorities.

I am working with Robert Pear from the Times on a set

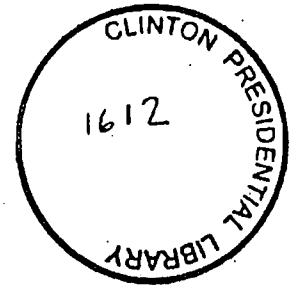

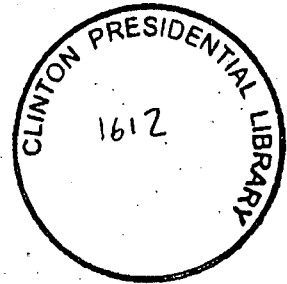
for the Conference. I sent him a copy of our SAP which would be the basis of the story.

At the right time we need to contact Senator Dole, who is desperate for a deal, to communicate that while we fight on the budget we can agree on welfare.



Crime:

I am beginning to believe that this story concerning youth violence will never run in the Times. Fox Butterfield promises that the story will run soon, but he is not sure of the timing..I am sent him additional information this week on the cops program.

When and if it runs, the story should provide us with the context to announce the success of our guns in school program, our new juvenile offender legislation, and drug testing for inmates.

It has been awhile since we have appeared in front of police and I believe we should use the legislation on youthful offenders to give a speech to a police academy.

Drugs:

This week we finally made some progress in the Administrations visibility. We were able to get Lee Brown on NBC with his attack on legalization as advocated by Hollywood. In addition to this announcement, we had Dr. Brown bring together area highschool coaches to push our policy of drug testing. Dr. Brown will get regional media with this announemenet. He is scheduled to speak to the national association in December.

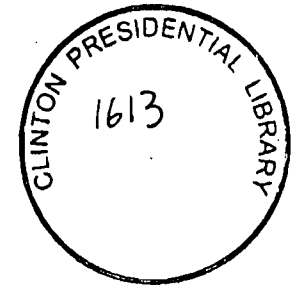

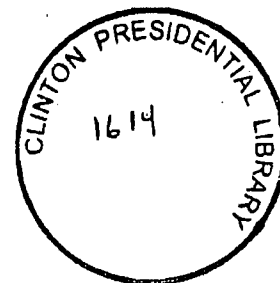

The Domestic Violence grants are ready for the Thursday event. The President will release \$50 million to police departments around the country.

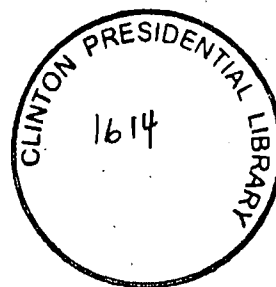
I have asked General McCaffrey to send me an agenda for the El Paso summit. I want to make sure our politics are covered and that we are not exposed too much on this issue.

CRIME/DRUGS: The curfew event was on all three networks and received very positive coverage. The Times and Post contrasted our curfew announcement against Senator Doles shaky event on Domestic Violence.

I am working with the Times on a larger follow

□

-up for this weekend on curfews. Fox Butterfield is the reporter who covers the crime beat and is interested in the study and the Presidents remarks. I am trying to put the curfew announcement into a larger juvenile agenda.

We have to decide if the letter to mayors and police chiefs concerning the Justice report should come from Reno or the President.

The next two announcement which focus on teens and adolescents are the truancy guidelines and the juvenile handgun tracking program. The department of Education has prepared their first draft of the truancy guidelines which I will review this weekend. ATF has an agreement with 20 cities to track the guns used by juveniles and use the information to crack down on the sellers of the weapons as well as the juveniles. I think this announcement would be very powerful.

Bruce and I were discussing the idea of how to expand the community schools program which keeps schools open after hours. One thought was to look into the possibility of signing a directive to the Secretary requiring a portion of Title I be spent on keeping schools open after hours.

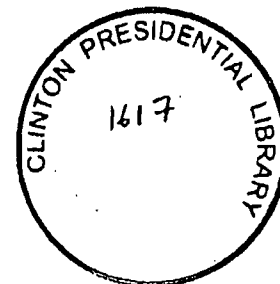
The Southwest border conference will be held July 11th in El Paso. The question is whether we still want to travel to Texas on July 11th not June 11th.

WELFARE: We had a meeting on Thursday with HHS staff to review the child support and paternity identification announcements. They will be ready to announce in the next two weeks.

I am very concerned with HHS's progress on the Wisconsin waiver. I do not think they are on track to have this completed in thirty days nor do they see this as their obligation.

In addition to Wisconsin HHS is working on 27 waivers some date as far back as 200 days. Just when we are beginning to get credit

for the state welfare reform experiment program this record could



undercut our agenda. In addition to the above waivers not a single letter has been sent from HHS to the Governors of N.J., Pennsylvania, Michigan, Mass., California, and New Hampshire. This was agreed to in you office two to three weeks ago. This will only get more complicated as the House begins to pass legislation requirring us to approve the state requests. The Wisconsin waiver request will be taken up as legislation on Tuesday.

In short, the old timeline HHS operated on no longer works and I do not think they fully appreciate that fact.

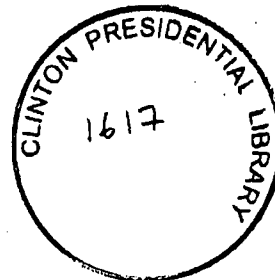
IMMIGRATION: On Tuesday Doris and US Attorney Alan Bersin announced 170 new agents for San Diego, two helicopters, and new FBI agents to combat the smuggling business. The announcement was covered extensivley in San Diego and L.A.

On Wednesday the AG and Governor Chiles announced the Florida immigration policy. The state plan relies heavily on the deportation and worksite agenda.

The LA Times are working on a story which compares Senator Doles campaign rhetoric with his voting record. The record and rhetoric do not match.

The Senate Immigration conferees continue to receive police letters and editorials opposed to the education amendment.

In the coming weeks we will sign a M.O.U. with Disney in Florida to participate in the computer verification program.

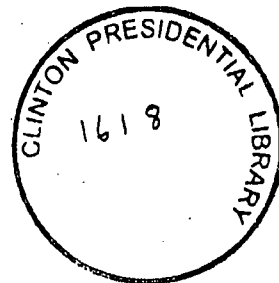
