Supports a resolution on the Middle East: Rabin needs it; Assad knows he no longer has the Soviet Union; the occupied territories have worse conditions than ever before; and you need this kind of achievement right now.

You need to focus on this issue. Sometimes fears Administration has a 10-year-old perception of where Jewish community is these days on Israel. The subject no longer brings a hard line attitude. It is doable, but you must become aggressive.
