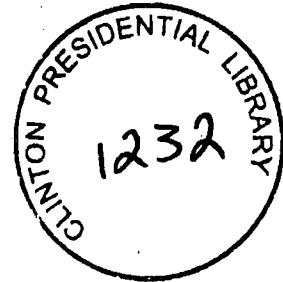

~~I don't think you should answer the RGA letter.~~ but if you did, I would say the following: I am pleased that governors in both parties agree with me that the conference report Congress sent me fell short in important areas, such as the need for more resources in child care. While I have real concerns about certain provisions in the NGA resolution on welfare reform, I hope it will help begin to foster here in Washington the spirit of bipartisan progress that has always been a hallmark of the NGA.

You can use the same boilerplate for Gov. Whitman. As to her specific proposal, you should just say he looks forward to reviewing the details, sounds interesting, etc.

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
