For domestic terrorism, I would recommend that we stay away from the Oklahoma victims and the State and local prosecutors because they want to talk about habeas and we want to talk about tools for Federal prosecutors.

- 1) Mary Jo White is the United States Attorney for the Southern District of New York and her office prosecuted the World Trade Center bombing case.
- 2) Janet Napolitano is the United States Attorney for the District of Arizona and is the Chair of the Attorney General's Advisory Committee.

I would also recommend Pat Ryan, the US Atty for Oklahoma but let me check w/ Justice because they might not want him doing interviews because he is involved in the prosecution of that case.



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
