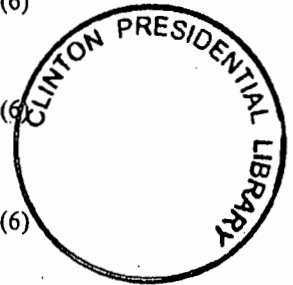

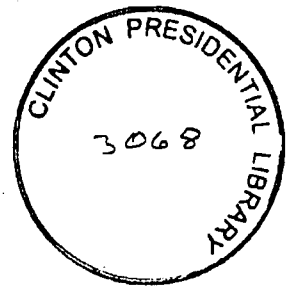

Since this issue does not seem to need action until Monday, I'm sending this email to you for you to get when you return. Wondering if there is a need for something beyond our usual ' we don't comment on pending nominations.'

Mike Remez of the Hartford Courant called again on Tuesday 5/30 regarding the expected nomination of CT AG Richard Blumenthal to a 2nd Circuit judgeship -- as you know the CT press have been calling regularly on this nomination matter for weeks. Remez noted that there were now rumors that the hold up on the nomination are the result of the current judge, Chief Judge Ralph Winter of 2nd Circuit, being reluctant to take on senior status -- even though he has told the press already of his intention to do so. Remez says Winter's office indicates he is set to take senior status on Oct 1, but wants to know if a lack of proper paperwork from his office is the holdup [and this is what Counsel's office has said is in fact the holdup that is stopping exec sec/clerk's office from being able to move on Blumenthal nom.]

Coming out of a meeting on judges that the Counsels office had today, Van Shima indicates that Sarah Wilson does not expect a letter announcing retirement to come from Judge Winter before Congress returns to session.

So with all the calls from CT press that will come when Congress resumes and nothing happens, I'm wondering if we will have anything else to say to explain the ongoing delay -- or just stick to usual no comment or redirect calls to Justice or elsewhere. Thanks.

Lake Worth shooting

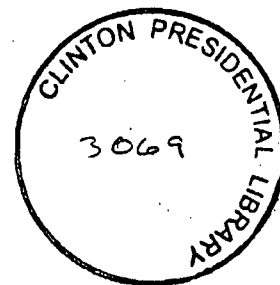

Blumenthal judicial nomination
