Dear Friends:

Thank you for expressing your concerns about the trafficking and sexual abuse of women and children. I am glad to have your views on this serious issue, and I regret that I have been unable to respond sooner.

Throughout my presidency, I have strived to protect the rights of women and children both at home and abroad. Earlier this month, I signed the instrument of ratification of the International Labor Organization's Convention on the Elimination of the Worst Forms of Child Labor. This document declares on behalf of the American people that we simply will not tolerate child slavery, the sale or trafficking of children, or child prostitution or pornography.

The rights of women are also an issue of global importance -- one that is integral to my Administration's foreign policy. As you note, too many societies continue to victimize women, limiting their access to education and economic opportunity, and forcing them to endure sexual, physical, and emotional abuse. Be assured that my Administration remains committed to combating these heinous crimes ~~against humanity~~, and we will not rest until women everywhere are free from the threat of persecution.

We will continue to press vigorously for an end to the trafficking and sexual enslavement of women and children. As we reaffirm our nation's fundamental belief in human dignity and our reverence for human rights, I am grateful for your involvement. Best regards.
