



## **Inventory for FOIA Request 2016-0984-F AV Segment 84 (1994, P19400-P19499)**

**All Presidential series photographs from the Clinton Administration taken on September 8, 1994 through September 12, 1994.**

### **Extent**

Approximately 1,844 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 84) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on September 8, 1994 through September 12, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs responsive to this segment were previously processed in FOIA case numbers 2020-0315-F & 2023-0675-F.

**Photographs from September 8, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton jogs on the Mall in Washington, DC.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the All-American Cities award ceremony in the Rose Garden of the White House. Following the event the President walks along the Colonnade with Loretta Avent towards the Oval Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks on the telephone in the Oval Office of the White House to Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin of Israel and President Carlos Menem of Argentina regarding Haiti.

President William Jefferson Clinton departs Andrews Air Force Base en route San Francisco, California.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at San Francisco International Airport. Present is Mayor Frank Jordan and Wendy Paskin-Jordan.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets candidate for Governor Kathleen Brown in San Francisco, California. The First Lady greets guests present at the Westin St. Francis hotel.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets police and guests on the tarmac at San Francisco International Airport. The First lady departs en route Sacramento, California. The First Lady arrives at Sacramento Metropolitan Airport. Present is Mayor Joe Serna and Representative Robert Matsui, among others. The First Lady makes remarks.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Hilton Hotel in Sacramento, California. The First Lady greets guests present including Steve Tremewan (Hilton Hotel manager) and the Farnsworth family. Following the event the First Lady proceeds to an event where she meets the Kolokotronis family.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets police and guests at Sacramento Metropolitan Airport. The First Lady departs Sacramento en route Santa Barbara, California.

**Photographs from September 9, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton greets teenagers from “Seeds of Peace” on the South Lawn of the White House prior to departure. Present are Martin Indyk and Ann McCoy. The President departs via Marine One. Also photographed are Bruce Lindsey, Dee Dee Myers, Grace Garcia, George Stephanopoulos, and Nancy Hrenreich in the White House prior to departure.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives in Alvin Callendar Field Air Station in Belle Chasse, Louisiana. Present includes Secretary of Housing & Urban Development Henry Cisneros, Senator John Breaux, and Thomas “Mack” McLarty. The President greets guests present and departs en route New Orleans.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses a Democratic National Committee business leadership forum event at the Ernest N. Morial convention center in New Orleans, Louisiana. Photographed includes Terry McAuliffe, Senator J. Bennett Johnston, Senator John Breaux, Representative William Jefferson and David Wilhelm, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the New Orleans Times Register editorial board.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses the National Baptist Convention at the Ernest N. Morial Convention Center in New Orleans, Louisiana. Present includes Reverend Jesse Jackson and Reverend Theodore Judson Jemison, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton visits Brighter Horizons Early Learning School in New Orleans, Louisiana. The President greets children & staff present.

President William Jefferson Clinton departs Alvin Callendar Field Air Station in Belle Chasse, Louisiana. Also present includes Bruce Lindsey and Dee Dee Myers. The President boards Air Force One and departs en route Andrews Air Force Base. The President returns to the White House from his trip to Louisiana. Marine One is photographed near the Lincoln Memorial & Reflecting Pool.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton departs Santa Barbara Airport en route San Diego, California. The First Lady greets guests present. The First Lady arrives at Jim Air Aviation Services Lindbergh Field. The First Lady makes remarks to guests. Photographed includes Representative Bob Filner and Kathleen Brown, among others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests at San Diego Airport prior to departing for Andrews Air Force Base.

**Photographs from September 10, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a foreign policy meeting in the Cabinet Room of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Tony Lake, Sandy Berger, Leon Fuerth, Pat Griffin, George Stephanopoulos, David Gergen, and Tom Ross.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in video & audio taping sessions for the Council of Jewish Federations, Conference of Presidents of Major Jewish Organizations, and the Office of Science and Technology Policy. Present includes Martin Indyk, Jock Gill, and Richard Strauss. Following the tapings the President converses with Dan Wexler. Later the President tapes a radio interview with Jim Hightower.

President William Jefferson Clinton signs a National Gang Safety Week proclamation in the Oval Office of the White House. Following the signing, the President delivers his weekly radio address. The President greets guests afterwards including Gordon Li, Rosie Norman, and Ricki Seidman. David Leavy speaks with the President.

**Photographs from September 11, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, and Chelsea Clinton ride bicycles in Washington, DC, and Virginia.

***(Photographs from September 11, 1994 continued:)***

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive at Phillips Army Airfield. Present is General Richard Tragemann, Kathy Tragemann, Senator Paul Sarbanes, and Colonel Wayne Smith, among others. The Clintons meet with AmeriCorps members at the post chapel. The President addresses the event and greets AmeriCorps members.

**Photographs from September 12, 1994 are as follows:**

President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed walking from Blair House in Washington, DC.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Ricki Seidman, Phil Lader, and Nancy Hernreich in the Oval Office of the White House and meets with Eli Segal in the Oval Office Dining Room. Also photographed is Wendy Smith and an unidentified aide.

President William Jefferson Clinton signs the National Voter Registration Executive Order, also called the “Motor Voter” law of 1994, in the Oval Office of the White House. Following the signing the President greets guests present. Later the President greets representatives from the Orthodox Union.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Cabinet Room of the White House with business leaders and corporate executives participating in AmeriCorps. Present include Eli Segal, Robert Sargent Shriver, Jr., and former Governor Tom Kean. The President is presented with a t-shirt.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with members of AmeriCorps in the Oval office of the White House. Present includes Eli Segal and Diana Aldridge. The President also meets alone with former Governor Tom Kean. The President and Governor Kean look at the President’s campaign button collection.

***(Please note: This event depicts the aftermath of a fatality. Discretion is advised.)*** Photographs of the aftermath of the plane crash of Frank Eugene Corder at the White House. The previous day on September 11, 1994, Corder stole a plane and took off from Harford County Airport in Churchville, Maryland. Corder flew the plane to the White House where he crashed onto the South Lawn and skidded into the White House. Photographed includes Leon Panetta, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, George Stephanopoulos, Mark Gearan, Al Madon, Phil Lader, and David Carpenter, among others. Also photographed are uniformed Secret Service officers canvassing the grounds and debris & wreckage being removed from the property.

**System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
