Approximately 2,384 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 85) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken September 12, 1994, through September 14, 1994. A photo contact sheet from September 13, 1994, was previously processed in case 2015-0709-F.

The Clinton Presidential records to be opened consist of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, official phone calls, photo-ops, etc. involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from September 12, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton swears in five new members of AmeriCorps Youth Service program in the Oval Office. Eli Segal, Chief Executive of the Corporation for National Service and others are present. President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Vice President Albert Gore, and Eli Segal address a larger AmeriCorps event on the North Portico of the White House. The President swears in hundreds of new members.

Federal officials look at the damage caused by airplane crash on the South Lawn at the White House. Officials clean up and investigate the crashed plane and site. The Cessna airplane skidded, struck a tree near the South Portico steps and hit the first-floor corner of the White House.

President Clinton walks along the White House Colonnade. President Clinton greets an unidentified man outside the Oval Office. Betty Currie and Nancy Hernreich were present.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Percy Malone and Donna Malone. President Clinton greets Lester Hosto in the Oval Office.

Candid shots of photographer Ralph Alswang in the West Wing Photo Office.

President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore greet Dave Everett in the Oval Office.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets a group of men with Loretta Avent outside the West Wing on West Executive Ave.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Black Juvenile Court Judges in the Indian Treaty Room in the Old Executive Office Building (EOB). Marian Wright Edelman and Alexis Herman were present at the meeting. The First Lady confers with Marian Wright Edelman, Alexis Herman, and Danny Wexler prior to addressing the judges.

President Clinton talks with Dee Dee Myers and George Stephanopoulos in the Outer Oval Office. Dee Dee Myers and George Stephanopoulos talk to Wendy Smith in the Outer Oval Office.

Photographs from September 13, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton addresses the Crime Bill ceremony on the South Lawn. President Clinton signs the bill at the ceremony. Dais participants include Vice President Albert Gore, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, Representative Tom Foley, Representative Richard Gephardt, Senator George Mitchell, Senator Diane Feinstein, Representative Pat Schroeder, Senator Edward “Ted” Kennedy, Senator Joseph Biden, Senator Patrick Leahy, Mayor Rudolph Giuliani of New York, Mayor Richard Daley of Chicago, Mayor Ed Rendell of Philadelphia, Mayor Kurt Schmoke of Baltimore, Mayor Sharpe James of Newark, Mayor Wellington Webb of Denver, Mayor Norman Rice of Seattle, and numerous police and law enforcement officials. The Clintons greet ceremony guests on the South Lawn. Prior to the ceremony President Clinton greets Senator Joseph Biden, Senator Patrick Moynihan, Secretary Lloyd Bentsen, Attorney General Janet Reno, Secretary Bruce Babbitt, and Representative Jack Brooks in the Cabinet Room.

President Clinton greets Patrick Hymas, Don Zimmerman, David Walsh, and Lee Douglass in the Oval Office.

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, Senator George Mitchell, Representative Tom Foley, Representative Richard Gephardt, and Leon Panetta.

President Clinton meets in the Cabinet Room regarding Haiti with Vice President Albert Gore, Madeleine Albright, Secretary William Perry, General John Shalikashvili, William Gray, David Gergen, Sandy Berger, Secretary Warren Christopher, Tony Lake, Leon Panetta, and others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets John Brademas and Ellen Lovell in the Map Room. The First Lady greets Laura Tayman in the hallway of the Ground Floor residence.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet the members of rock band The Eagles including Don Henley, Glen Frey, Joe Walsh, Don Felder, and Timothy B. Schmit in the Oval Office. The band presents the President with a guitar. The First Lady has lunch with the band in the White House Staff Mess. Don Henley greets Nancy Hernreich in the Outer Oval Office.

Photographs from September 13, 1994, Continued:

President Clinton meets in the Oval Office with Mort Zuckerman. Mack McLarty was present at the meeting,

President Clinton drops by a meeting with the leadership of the U.S. Conference of Mayors that Vice President Albert Gore is hosting in his West Wing office.

President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office to President Fidel Ramos of the Philippines regarding Haiti.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton host the President's Cup Dinner in the State Dining Room for members of the American and International golf teams. President Clinton poses for group photos for members of the American team and the international team on the South Portico steps and the Blue Room. The Clintons greet guests in the Blue Room. Guests include Phil Mickelson, Brent Musburger, Bryant Gumbel, among others. The President is presented a crystal bowl by Tim Finchem, Commissioner of the Pro Golf Association (PGA) Tour. White House Pastry Chef Roland Mesnier looks over desserts during the dinner.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks alone with Senator Harris Wofford on the Colonnade.

Photographs from September 14, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton jogs along the Potomac River and past the Lincoln Memorial Reflecting Pool with Jim Lyons and Kate Pflaumer in Washington, D.C.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks alone in the West Wing to Molly Raiser.

President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office to foreign leaders regarding Haiti. Jim Reed, National Security Council, sets up the telephone calls. Sandy Berger, George Stephanopoulos, Tony Lake, and Leon Panetta stand nearby in the Oval Office.

President Clinton and Vice President Albert Gore address a National Performance Review Reinventing Government (REGO) event on the South Lawn. President Clinton uses scissors to cut "Red Tape" which is on display on the South Lawn. President Clinton greets ceremony guests including Alice Rivlin, Jame Lee Witt, among others.

Photographs from September 14, 1994, Continued:

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet actor Robert Redford and his guests in the Oval Office. Robert Redford greets Debi Schiff, Wendy Smith, Heather Beckel, Betty Currie, Kelly Crawford, and Nancy Hernreich in the Outer Oval Office and West Wing hallway.

Betty Currie arranges papers on President Clinton's desk in the Oval Office.

President Clinton talks on the telephone in the Oval Office.

President Clinton addresses a group of U.S. Attorneys General in the State Dining Room. The President was joined by Attorney General Janet Reno, Leon Panetta, and others at the event.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level.

While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
