### **All Presidential series photographs from the Clinton Administration taken from September 14, 1994, through September 18, 1994**

#### **Extent**

Approximately 2,089 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 86) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken September 14, 1994, through September 18, 1994. Several photo contact sheets from September 16, 1994, were previously processed in case 2018-0084-F.

The Clinton Presidential records to be opened consist of photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, official phone calls, photo-ops, etc. involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

**Photographs from September 14, 1994, are as follows:**

President Clinton addresses a group of U.S. Attorneys General in the State Dining Room. The President was joined by Attorney General Janet Reno, Leon Panetta, Mary Joe White, Chair of the Attorneys General Advisory Committee, and others at the event.

President Clinton participates in an interview regarding Haiti with wire service reporters including Helen Thomas in the Oval Office.

President Clinton drops by a meeting in the Map Room with the returning Presidential Mission to Central Africa. Tony Lake was present at the meeting.

**Photographs from September 15, 1994, are as follows:**

President Clinton jogs with Tim Finchem, PGA Tour Commissioner, along the Potomac River in Washington, D.C., After their jog together they talk in the Oval Office.

President Clinton walks along the White House Colonnade towards the residence with Vice President Albert Gore and Tony Lake.

President Clinton meets with the National Black Caucus of State Legislators in the Diplomatic Reception Room.

President Clinton talks with Kirk Hanlin, Nancy Hernreich, Tony Lake, and Leon Panetta in the Oval Office.

Secretary William Perry talks with General John Shalikashvili, Sandy Berger, Strobe Talbott and Nancy Soderberg in the Outer Oval Office.

President Clinton walks along the Colonnade towards the West Wing with Wendy Smith.

President Clinton greets Ann Bartley with Nancy Hernreich in the Oval Office.

President Clinton addresses a ceremony for “Forgotten Hero” World War II veterans at the Longworth House Office Building at the U.S. Capitol. Dais participants include Representative Bobby Rush, Representative Charles Rangel, Representative Kweisi Mfume, Representative Maxine Waters, and others. President Clinton and Secretary Jesse Brown greet the honorees.

President Clinton looks at a “President Clinton” brochure with Vice President Albert Gore in the Outer Oval Office. President Clinton and Vice President Gore talk with Tony Lake in the Outer Oval Office.

**Photographs from September 17, 1994, are as follows:**

President Clinton delivers his weekly radio address in the Oval Office. Following the address, President Clinton greets guests in the Oval Office.

President Clinton meets with military advisors at the Pentagon regarding Haiti. Meeting participants include Vice Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff Admiral William Owens, Vice President Albert Gore, Secretary William Perry, General Gordon Sullivan, Admiral Mike Boorda, General Carl Mundy, Admiral Robert Kramek, General Thomas Moorman, Tony Lake, and Leon Panetta. President Clinton tours the Pentagon's National Military Command Center. President Clinton greets military personnel and others at the Pentagon.
