All Presidential series photographs from the Clinton Administration taken on September 18, 1994 through September 21, 1994

#### **Extent**

Approximately 2,434 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

#### Access

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 87) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on September 18, 1994 through September 21, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Of particular focus is meetings regarding Haiti and announcing the special envoys to Haiti.

Select material responsive to this segment was previously processed in FOIA case number 2023-0675-F.

# Photographs from September 18, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with senior staff in the Oval Office and Outer Oval Office of the White House regarding the situation in Haiti. Present include Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Strobe Talbott, General John Shalikashvili, Leon Furth, Secretary of Defense William Perry, Leon Panetta, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, and Betty Currie.

#### Photographs from September 19, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton attends a working breakfast in the State Dining Room of the White House to discuss the situation in Haiti. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., former President Jimmy Carter, General Colin Powell, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Senator Sam Nunn, Secretary of Defense William Perry, Madeleine Albright, General John Shalikashvili, Senator George Mitchell, Senator Robert Byrd, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Senator Joseph Kennedy, Representative Thomas Foley, Leon Panetta, Senator Ron Dellums, Lloyd Cutler, and Senator Carol Moseley-Braun, among others. Prior to the meeting the President is briefed in the Treaty Room in the White House Residence.

President William Jefferson Clinton holds a press conference in the East Room of the White House regarding the situation in Haiti. The President announces a special envoy to Haiti, which includes former President Jimmy Carter, General Colin Powell, and Senator Sam Nunn. Following the press conference the President walks back to the Oval Office with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., and Leon Panetta. The President meets along with Senator Chris Dodd in the Oval Office.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the Nina Hyde "Fashion Targets Breast Cancer" event in the East Room of the White House. Following the event the First Lady greets guests in the Blue Room. Present include Ralph Lauren, Donna Karan, Oscar de la Renta, Dr. Marc Lippman, and Susan Blumenthal.

#### Photographs from September 20, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Harold Ickes & Nancy Hernreich in the Oval Office of the White House. The President greets Bernard Rapaport, Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, and Mark Middleton in the Outer Oval Office.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with the Organization of American States Secretary General César Septembero Gaviria Trujillo in the Oval Office of the White House.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with Mayor of Paris, France Jacques Chirac in the Oval Office of the White House. Also present is Secretary of State Warren Christopher. Later the President greets Sandra Murphy.

President William Jefferson Clinton drops by a meeting with Northern Ireland Labor Party leader John Hume in the Vice President's West Wing office of the White House. Also present is Vice President Albert Gore, Jr.

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Suzanna Valdez, Secretary of Transportation Federico Pena, and Joe Valasquez in the Green Room of the White House prior to a reception in the East Room. Following the event the President greets guests for the reception in the Blue Room.

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses an event for Representative Bob Michel at the Grand Hyatt Hotel in Washington, DC. Present include Representative Michel and John Brazil (President; Bradley University), among others.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton meets with Mayor of Paris, France Jacques Chirac in the Residence of the White House. Also present is Nancy Abraham.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Dirksen Building on Capitol Hill for the National Summit on Learning Disabilities. Present is Senator Christopher Dodd.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at the Discovery Day Care Center in Conshohocken, Pennsylvania. The First Lady greets personnel & children and participates in an announcement for Mercy Health Corporation Primary Care initiative. Also photographed are Carol Rabe (CEO; Discovery Day Care) and Plato Marinakos (President & CEO; Mercy Health Corporation.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Philadelphia International Airport in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. The First Lady greets Mayor Ed Rendell and guests. The First Lady proceeds to the Wyndham Franklin Plaza hotel in Philadelphia.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attends an event at the Pennsylvania Convention Center for Representative Marjorie Margolis-Mezvinsky in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. Present is Mayor Ed Rendell, among others. The First Lady is photographed in a room prior to the event.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests at Philadelphia International Airport prior to departure.

# Photographs from September 21, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton meets with union officials at the Hay Adams hotel in Washington, DC.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the 1994 National Heritage Fellowship reception in the Senate Caucus Room on Capitol Hill in Washington, DC. The First Lady presents framed certificates to the National Heritage fellows. Also present is Jane Alexander (Chairperson; National Endowment for the Arts).

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses the National Farmers Union in Room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building in Washington, DC. Present includes Mike Lux, Secretary of Agriculture Mike Espy, and Lee Swenson (President; Farmers Union).

# **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
