Scope and Content

FOIA 2006-1135-F is a request for all Clinton administration White House photographs taken in 1993.

The photographs processed in segment 7 were created from January 20, 1993 through January 25, 1993. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, and staff for the time period processed.

Inauguration ceremony at the U.S. Capitol (The photos from the Inaugural include overall wide angle shots of the ceremony at the U.S. Capitol, President Clinton delivering his Inaugural address and the poet Maya Angelou reading her poem at the ceremony)

White House Open House event (The Clintons and the Gores welcome visitors from the outside stairs of the South Portico of the White House and greet the public in a receiving line the Diplomatic Reception room of the White House)
