Approximately 2,449 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives and born-digital files.

Access

Scope and Content

FOIA 2008-0666-F (Segment 4) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from July 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000.

The photographs processed in this segment were created from July 11, 2000, July 13, 2000, July 17, 2000, and July 19, 2000 through July 23 2000. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, Hillary Rodham Clinton, Chelsea Clinton, staff and others for the time period processed.

The majority of the photographs in this date range for this segment were processed under FOIA 2016-0242-F, which subject matter pertains to the Middle East peace process. While other segments of this FOIA consist of processing one photograph book as one segment, the overall low number count of images not processed under FOIA 2016-0242-F and subsequently responsive to this segment led to a processing decision to be made to combine photograph books 839 and 840 as one segment.

Photographs from July 13, 2000 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton delivers a statement in the Rose Garden at the White House on a United States/Vietnam bilateral trade agreement. Senators John McCain and John Kerry are present, among others. The President departs the White House via Marine One.

Photographs from July 17, 2000 are as follows:

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives at Ellis Island, New York. Senator Frank Lautenberg, Senator Robert Graham & Mrs. Adele Graham, and Council Member Catherine Fred are present, among others. The First Lady addresses the Ellis Island White House Millennium Council Save America's Treasures event.

Photographs from July 19, 2000 are as follows:

Photographs from July 20, 2000 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton and Chelsea Clinton disembark Air Force One at Naha Airport in Okinawa, Japan. Present are Samuel "Sandy" Berger and Ambassador Tom Foley. The principals greet Japanese officials present.

Photographs from July 21, 2000 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a G-7 Summit session in the conference hall at Bankoku Shinryokan. Present are Prime Minister Yoshiro Mori of Japan, Prime Minister Tony Blair of Great Britain, President Jacques Chirac of France, and Prime Minister Jean Chretien of Canada.

President William Jefferson Clinton attends a G-8 Summit working dinner at the Bankoku Shinryokan convention center. Present are Prime Minister Yoshiro Mori of Japan, President Vladimir Putin of Russia, Prime Minister Tony Blair of Great Britain, President Jacques Chirac of France, and Prime Minister Jean Chretien of Canada.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a briefing with senior staff at the Vusena Terrace Hotel in Okinawa, Japan. Present are Gene Sperling, Jim Steinberg, Joe Lockhart, Lael Brainard, Maria Echaveste, Larry Summers, Samuel "Sandy" Berger, and Strobe Talbott. The President meets with President Vladimir Putin of Russia.

(July 21, 2000 cont.)

President William Jefferson Clinton and Chelsea Clinton tour the Cornerstone of Peace Park with Governor Keiichi Inamine. The President delivers remarks at the park. Seated on the dais are also Governor Inamine and Machika Kawamitsu.

Chelsea Clinton goes sightseeing in Okinawa. Present is Huma Abedin.

Photographs from July 22, 2000 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a bilateral meeting with Prime Minister Yoshiro Mori of Japan at the Vusena Terrace Hotel in Okinawa, Japan.

President William Jefferson Clinton arrives at the Bankoku Shinryokan convention center. The President greets G-7 Summit leaders. The President and leaders participate in a tree planting ceremony in the garden at Bankoku Shinryokan.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a G-8 Summit session at the Bankoku Shinryokan convention center. President William Jefferson Clinton and Chelsea Clinton attend a G-8 Summit reception and dinner at the Shuri Castle in Okinawa, Japan.

Photographs from July 23, 2000 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses American troops at Camp Foster in Okinawa, Japan. Dias participants include Lieutenant General Earl Hailston, Brigadier General James B. Smith, Brigadier General Gary Hughey, Rear Admiral Paul S. Schultz and Colonel Michael J. Sullivan.

President William Jefferson Clinton and Chelsea Clinton greet people at Kadena Air Base prior to departing Okinawa, Japan for Alaska and en route to Andrews Air Force Base.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
