SUBJECT: Tasker for Presidential Meeting with Irish Prime
 Minister Bruton, March 17, 1997

The Department of State and Central Intelligence Agency should provide appropriate briefing materials for the President's meeting with Prime Minister Bruton of Ireland on March 17. This material should include, but not be limited to, the briefing items described below. (U)

Public Statements. (Talking points/bullets, double-spaced on plain bond paper)

Draft toast/remarks at the evening event. (U)

Press Material. (Double-spaced on plain bond; Q&A's should run continuous and be single-spaced with two line feeds between each question and answer.)

Draft statement to the press following the meeting. Q's and A's. (U)

Briefing Material. (Two-to-five pages, with a three-part format:

"Context of Meeting," "Your Objectives" and "Suggested Talking Points.")

Meeting with Prime Minister Bruton (U)

Issues Papers. These papers should identify the key issues to be raised during the President's meetings with Irish Prime Minister Bruton. The papers should be in the core objectives/background/points-to-be-made format. The core objectives section should describe the President's two-three goals for the issue in bullet format. The background section should be single-spaced and give the

context for the issue and provide essential background information.

The points-to-be-made should be in bullet format. Issues papers should be no more than two pages in length.

Status of Northern Ireland peace process
Prospects for Belfast Peace Talks
IRA Violence
Contacts with Role of Sinn Fein
EU Developments Since Irish Presidency (C)

Background Papers. (One page long with the exception of very complex topics, single-spaced in full sentence format; in three sections: one-to-two sentences on "Statement of the Issue," two-to-three bullets on "Key Points" and a few paragraphs on "Background.")

Political overview
Irish neutrality
Humanitarian and peacekeeping contributions (including Bosnia)
Impact of British/Irish Elections on Peace Process (C)

Biographies. Biographies 1.4c, 3.5c should be provided for each foreign official the President will meet. (U)

While the Department of State bears primary responsibility for the preparation of these briefing materials, all other appropriate agencies should be closely involved in the preparation of these papers and all final papers should be fully cleared. All briefing materials are due by close of business, March 7 and should include an IBM compatible diskette using Word for Windows 2.0 or 6.0 as well as a hard copy. (U).
