Scope and Content

The materials in FOIA 2021-0641-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of photographs responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

The content consists of photographs regarding the signing of the Balkan Peace Agreement at the Quai D'Orsay (Foreign Ministry) in Paris, France on December 14, 1995. Photographs include: Balkan Peace Agreement signing by President Slobodan Milosevic of Serbia, President Alija Izetbegovic of Bosnia and President Franjo Tudjman of Croatia; President William Jefferson Clinton, President Jacques Chirac of France and Chancellor Helmut Kohl of Germany signing the agreement documents along with Prime Minister John Major of the United Kingdom, Prime Minister Viktor Chernomyrdin of Russia and Prime Minister Felipe Gonzalez of Spain signing the agreement documents; Ceremony Principals addressing the peace agreement ceremony; U.N. Secretary General Boutros Boutros-Ghali and NATO Secretary General Solana addressing the

peace agreement ceremony; Ceremony Principals participating in a luncheon with Secretary of State Warren Christopher and Richard Holbrooke attending; President Clinton departing the Quai D'Orsay in Paris with President Jacques Chirac presiding.

Other events that were included on the responsive photo contact sheets include:

President Clinton arriving at Orly Airport in Paris, France on December 14, 1995; President Clinton greeting Daniel Jouanneau, Chief of Protocol, France on the tarmac after arriving in Paris.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
