1,129 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

### **Scope and Content**

The materials in FOIA 2021-0646-F are a selective, not necessarily all inclusive, body of documents responsive to the topic of the FOIA. Researchers should consult the archivist about related materials.

FOIA request 2021-0646-F contains photographs from the White House Photograph Office. The state dinner for King Juan Carlos I and Queen Sofia at the White House took place on February 23, 2000. In addition to the state dinner, photographs of state dinner preparations are included. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton hosted a state dinner in the State Dining Room of the White House for King Juan Carlos I and Queen Sofia of Spain. The heads of state greeted guests with a receiving line in the Grand Foyer of the White House. President Clinton and King Juan Carlos I delivered remarks and toasts at the dinner. Notable guests at the dinner include Secretary of State Madeleine Albright, Dale Chihuly, Janet Murguia, Mickey Ibarra, Abe Pollin, Whoopi Goldberg, Dennis Quaid, Meg Ryan, Diane Keaton, and others. President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visited with King Juan Carlos I and Queen Sofia and others in the Yellow Oval Room. The Strolling Strings and Marine Band performed at the State Dinner. Spanish Opera singer Placido Domingo performed with Ana

Maria Martinez in the East Room following the dinner. Photographs show residence staff vacuuming the red carpet in the North Portico entrance to the Grand Foyer and a piano tuner tuning the Steinway Eagle Pedestal Piano. Dinner table settings, floral arrangements, menus, and plated desserts are included in the photographs.

### **System of Arrangement**

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the incidental processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
