Approximately 2,090 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 113) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994, through December 31, 1994. The photographs processed in this segment were created on October 27, 1994; November 24, 1994, through December 1, 1994. Photo contact sheets in this segment from October 27, 1994, and November 24, 1994, were previously processed in cases 2016-0242-F and 2018-0115-F. The Finding Aid inventory will reflect the previously processed photo contact sheets.

The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from November 25, 1994, are as follows:

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in a discussion with Carl Anthony for his George University class on First Ladies at the Mayflower Hotel in Washington. The First Lady takes questions from the class.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level.

While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
