Extent

Approximately 2,465 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 111) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994 through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on November 16, 1994 through November 21, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed. Of particular focus is a trip to Jakarta, Indonesia and Hawaii.

Photographs from November 16, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton practices driving golf balls at a driving range in Jakarta, Indonesia. Later the President visits shops along an unidentified route.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet United States embassy staff at the Hilton Hotel Convention Center in Jakarta, Indonesia. The President & First Lady address the staff & guests. Present includes Secretary of State Warren Christopher, Ambassador Robert Barry, and Peggy Barry. Also photographed is Kelly Craighead. Later the President pays a courtesy call to Indonesian Vice President Try Sutrisno. Present includes Foreign Minister Ali Alatas (علي العطاس), Ambassador Barry, Tony Lake

President William Jefferson Clinton addresses business representatives at the Hilton Hotel Convention Center in Jakarta, Indonesia. Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown also addresses the group. Prior to the event the President greets American business representative in a separate event.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton is photographed at the Hilton Hotel in Jakarta, Indonesia. She participates in an interview with local media in a hallway. Present is Karen Finney. The First Lady greets guests present at the hotel.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend a state dinner hosted by President Suharto and Mrs. Siti Hartinah at the Istana Negara Palace in Jakarta, Indonesia. President Clinton & President Suharto deliver remarks, make a toast during the dinner, and greet guests prior to the event. A cultural performance is held during dinner. The President & First Lady bid farewell before proceeding to the Halim Perdana Kusumah airport. *Archivist note: Soeharto has no family name, and Suharto is the modern spelling of the name.*

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton bid farewell to Foreign Minister Ali Alatas (علي العطاس) and Mrs. Peggy Barry prior to departing Halim Perdana Kusumah airport in Jakarta, Indonesia en route Hawaii. The President & First Lady disembark Air Force One at Hickam Air Base in Hawaii. They are met by Governor John Waihee, Mrs. Lynne Waiheee, Admiral Richard C. Macke, Brigadier General Dwight M. Kealoah, Governor-elect Benjamin J. Cayetano, Lieutenant Governor-elect Mazie Keiko Hirono (広野慶子), Leighton Kim Oshima, Senator Daniel Kahikina Akaka, Mary Akaka, Representative Neil Abercrombie, Representative Patsy T. Mink, and John Mink, among others. The President address guests at an arrival ceremony. Also photographed is Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown. The President & First Lady greet guests present and are given lei to wear.

Photographs from November 17, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton plays golf at Wai'ala'e Country Club in Honolulu, Hawaii. Present is Governor John Waihee, Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, Governor-Elect Benjamin Cayetano, Larry Price, and Judge Klein. Also photographed are Mort Engelberg and Plez Transou.

Miscellaneous material includes Patsy Thomasson presenting the Office of Administration awards in Room 450 of the Old Executive Office Building

Photographs from November 18, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton golfs at the Mid-Pacific Country Club in Kailua, Hawaii. Present includes Governor John Waihee, Senator Daniel Akaka, and Russell Okata.

President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton address a tribute to Governor John Waihee at the Mid-Pacific Conference Center at the Hilton Hawaiian Village in Honolulu, Hawaii.

Miscellaneous material includes Nancy Hernreich in the Oval Office at the White House.

Photographs from November 19, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton is photographed at the Kaneohe Klipper golf course on Marine Corps Base Hawaii in Oahu, Hawaii. Later the President greets patrons at Buzz's Original Steak House in Kailua, Hawaii.

Miscellaneous photographs taken in Hawaii include President William Jefferson Clinton & First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton at the Marine Corps Base, and White House staff including Sharon Farmer, Ralph Alswang, Kelly Craighead, and Stephen Goodin photographed at various points.

Photographs from November 20, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton bid farewell to Governor John Waihee & Admiral Richard Macke, among others, and Hickam Air Force Base in Hawaii. The President & First Lady disembark Air Force One at Andrews Air Force Base and later arrive at the South Lawn Landing Zone of the White House via Marine One.

Photographs from November 21, 1994 are as follows:

President William Jefferson Clinton speaks with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., and Betty Currie in the Outer Oval Office of the White House. Later the President is in the Oval Office and presented with credentials from Ambassador Ismail Ould Iyahi of Mauritania.

President William Jefferson Clinton participates in a budget meeting in the Oval office of the White House. Present includes Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen, Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown, Laura Tyson, Leon Panetta, Carol Rasco, Pat Griffin, Erskine Bowles, Alice Rivlin, Robert Rubin, Harold Ickes, George Stephanopoulos, Gene Sperling, and Jack Quinn, among others.

President William Jefferson Clinton meets in the Oval Office of the White House with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr., General John Shalikashvili, John Deutch, Secretary of State Warren Christopher, and Anthony Lake. The President participates in an expanded meeting with Prime Minister Yitzhak Rabin of Israel. Additionally present include Martin Indyk, Mark Gearan, George Stephanopoulos, and Dennis Ross. The press pool covers the top of the meeting. Molly Raiser is photographed speaking with Prime Minister Rabin prior to the meeting, and the Prime Minister greets Secretary of Commerce Ron Brown and Secretary of the Treasury Lloyd Bentsen. Immediately prior to the meeting the President converses with Vice President Gore, Christopher, Ross, Indyk, Lake, and Leon Panetta.

President William Jefferson Clinton greets Secretary General of NATO Willy Claes in Anthony Lake's office in the West Wing of the White House. Later the President speaks with Vice President Albert Gore, Jr, and Leon Panetta. The Vice President shows the President his carved cane.

System of Arrangement

Records that were responsive to this FOIA request were found in one collection area and one series—Clinton Presidential Records: Photographs of the White House Photograph Office and the series therein—Photographs Relating to the Clinton Administration. Processing is done at the Folder/Contact sheet level. While this method maintains folder/contact sheet integrity, it frequently results in the processing of photographs that are not wholly responsive to the subject area.
