Scope and Content

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 8) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 27, 1994, through January 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment contains photographic events pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed.

Photographs from January 27, 1994, are as follows:

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrives in Los Angeles, California. She was met at the airport by Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Director James Lee Witt, FEMA employees and members of the U.S. Army National Guard.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participates in an event at Hyde Park Elementary School in Los Angeles. The First Lady, Deputy Secretary of Education, Madeleine Kunin, and others have a discussion with children, parents, and crisis counselors on crisis therapy. The First Lady addresses children from the school playground. The First Lady greets school faculty, board members of school district, and others. FEMA Director James Lee Witt, Mayor of Los Angeles Richard Riordan, Representative Julian Dixon, School Principal Mattye Fegan were all present at the school.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton views earthquake damage in Los Angeles with FEMA Director James Lee Witt, and others. During her viewing of the damage, the First Lady greets Los Angeles Conservation Corps Youth.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Hotel Roosevelt personnel in Los Angeles.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets police officers, and others before departing at Burbank Airport in Los Angeles.

Photographs from January 28, 1994, are as follows:

President Clinton greets a group of people on the South Lawn driveway prior to departing to Piney Point, Maryland.

President Clinton crosses the South Lawn with Andrew Friendly, Thomas "Mack" McLarty, Paul Begala, George Stephanopoulos, Pat Griffin, and others before departing on Marine One for Piney Point.

President Clinton participates and addresses a House Democratic Caucus Issues at the Seafarers Hotel and Training Center in Piney Point, Maryland.

President Clinton arrives on the South Lawn after visiting Piney Point.

President Clinton, Vice President Al Gore, Attorney General Janet Reno, and Director Lee Brown meeting with Mayors in the East Room.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton visits, tours, and meets with patients, hospital personnel, and families at University Medical Center in Las Vegas, Nevada. The First Lady participates in a group discussion with patients and their families.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses a Health Care Forum at the Thomas & Mack Center on the campus of the University of Nevada – Las Vegas. The First Lady is joined on stage by Senator Harry Reid, Governor Bob Miller of Nevada, and others.

System of Arrangement
