### **All Presidential series photographs from the Clinton Administration taken from November 4, 1994, through November 7, 1994**

#### **Extent**

Approximately 2,851 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives.

#### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

#### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2016-0984-F (Segment 106) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from January 1, 1994, through December 31, 1994.

The photographs processed in this segment were created on November 4, 1994, through November 7, 1994. The segment contains photographs pertaining to arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President William Jefferson Clinton, First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton, White House Staff, and others for the time period processed.

**Photographs from November 4, 1994, are as follows:**

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets Congressional candidate John Tiernay at the Peabody Community Life Center in Peabody, Massachusetts. They participate in a discussion with senior community leaders.

**Photographs from November 5, 1994, are as follows:**

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses a Bill Curry for Governor event at Bushnell Memorial Concert Hall in Hartford, Connecticut.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton addresses a Bill Curry for Governor Rally on the steps of the state capitol in Hartford.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton and Chelsea Clinton greet guests at a reception for the Washington Ballet in the State Dining Room.

President Clinton arrives at Alameda Naval Air Station in Oakland, California and greets people on the tarmac.

President Clinton and Kathleen Brown address a Get Out the Vote Rally at the Henry J. Kaiser Convention Center in Oakland. Rally participants include Senator Diane Feinstein, Representative Ron Dellums, and Oakland Mayor Elihu Harris.

President Clinton greets a Make-A-Wish Foundation child and his family at the Fairmont Hotel in San Francisco, California. The President greets people at the hotel.

**Photographs from November 6, 1994, are as follows:**

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets guests at a reception for Blair House in the Blue Room of the White House.

President Clinton attends service at Grace Episcopal Church in San Francisco.

**Photographs from November 6, 1994, Continued:**

President Clinton participates in an interview with political reporters at the Fairmont Hotel in San Francisco. The reporters include Phil Trounstein, San Jose Mercury News, Mark Barabak, San Diego Union Tribune, John Jacobs, Sacramento Bee, Steve Capps, San Francisco Examiner, Ed Epstein, San Francisco Chronicle, Amy Wallace, Los Angeles Daily News, and Billy Stahl, Los Angeles Times. Dee Dee Myers is present during the interview. President Clinton talks on the telephone in his suite at the Fairmont Hotel. Alexis Herman and Harold Ickes are present during the telephone call.

President Clinton departs San Francisco International Airport and travels to Seattle, Washington.

President Clinton arrives at King County Airport in Seattle. The President is met by Senator Patty Murray and family. President Clinton greets people at the airport.

President Clinton addresses a Get Out The Vote Rally at the Pike Place Market in Seattle. Rally participants include Senator Patty Murray, Ron Sims, and Governor Mike Lowry.

President Clinton walks from Pike Place Market to Market Place North Building. President Clinton greets Larry King and crew prior to taping an interview with Larry King. President Clinton confers with Dee Dee Myers, Harold Ickes, and Stephen Goodin after the interview.

President Clinton arrives at the airport in Minneapolis, Minnesota. The President greets Representative Martin Sabo and others at the airport.

**Photographs from November 7, 1994, are as follows:**

President Clinton meets with Bruce Lindsey, Harold Ickes, and Dee Dee Myers in his office aboard Air Force One. While aboard Air Force One, President Clinton talks on the telephone and works at his desk. First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks with Harold Ickes aboard Air Force One. President Clinton talks with Bruce Lindsey, Harold Ickes, and Janice Enright in the conference room aboard Air Force One.

First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greets people at the Minneapolis Hotel and Towers.

**Photographs from November 7, 1994, Continued:**

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton address a rally at North Hennepin Community College in Minneapolis. Senator Paul David Wellstone, Kay Sloan, and Ann Wynn make brief remarks at the rally. Following the rally, President Clinton talks to David Wilhelm and Harold Ickes. President Clinton talks on the telephone in the presidential limousine in Minneapolis.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet people at Minneapolis International Airport prior to departing to Flint, Michigan. The Clintons climb the stairs of Air Force One and depart Minneapolis.

President Clinton talks on the telephone and reads the newspaper aboard Air Force One. Dee Dee Myers and Bruce Lindsey are with the President on Air Force One.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton disembark Air Force One at the airport in Flint, Michigan. The Clintons are met by Representative Bob Carr and his family.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton participate in a rally for Representative Bob Carr and other democratic candidates at the University of Michigan in Flint. President Clinton talks on the telephone and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton talks with Kelly Craighead and Wendy Smith in the locker room at the University of Michigan. Bruce Lindsey and Dee Dee Myers are present in the locker room.

The Clintons depart Flint, Michigan and travel to Wilmington, Delaware.

The Clintons arrive in Wilmington and are met by Senator Joseph Biden, Governor Tom Carper, and Martha Carper. Views of Air Force One on the tarmac at sunset.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton attend a rally at Roney Square in Wilmington. Rally participants include Senator Joseph Biden, Governor Tom Carper, and Attorney General Charles Oberly. The President talks alone with Senator Biden.

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton greet people at the Wilmington Airport. President Clinton talks with Senator Joe Biden prior to departing for Andrews Air Force Base. During the flight the Clintons host a farewell reception for Wendy Smith in the Conference Room aboard Air Force One. Reception participants include Bruce Lindsey, Kelly Craighead, Harold Ickes, Dee Dee Myers, Marsha Scott, Josh King, and others.

## **Photographs from November 7, 1994, Continued:**

President Clinton and First Lady Hillary Rodham Clinton arrive on the South Lawn and disembark Marine One and walk across the South Lawn to the White House.

### **System of Arrangement**
