### **Extent**

Approximately 2,379 photographs in color and black & white film processed from 35mm negatives and born digital images.

### **Access**

Collection is open to all researchers. Access to Clinton Presidential Records is governed by the Presidential Records Act (PRA) (44 U.S.C. Chapter 22, as amended) and the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) (5 U.S.C. 552, as amended) and therefore records may be restricted in whole or in part in accordance with legal exemptions.

### **Scope and Content**

FOIA 2008-0666-F (Segment 23) is a request for all Clinton Administration White House photographs taken from July 1, 2000 through December 31, 2000.

The photographs processed in this segment were created from October 22, 2000 through October 25, 2000. The segment contains photographs pertaining to: arrivals, departures, meetings, ceremonies, press briefings, interviews, photo-ops, etc., involving President Clinton, White House Staff and others for the time period processed.
